




### U.S. Investment in Romania between 1997 and 2020


### U.S. Direct and Indirect Investment in Romania 2019 - 2020


### Structure of Foreign Investment in Romania, by country of origin


#### Structure of U.S. Investments in Romania, based on turnover

## **Commercial Relations between the U.S. and Romania**

Trade between Romania and the U.S. increased from USD 2.5 billion in 2011 to USD 5.4 billion in 2021. In billateral trade, we see a commercial surplus for Romania.





### 2021 trade in services **USD 1.1 billion**








### U.S. Direct Investments in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE)

### Conclusions

- The U.S. are the 5th largest foreign investor in Romania and the largest non-European foreign investor.
- Most investments have been chanelled towards manufacturing (including automotive and FMCG) and Agri-food.
- FDI-wise, a regional comparison (with benchmark countries in the CEE region) shows that there is potential for growth of U.S. FDI in Romania.
- > Trade between the U.S. and Romania grew steadily over the last 10 years.
